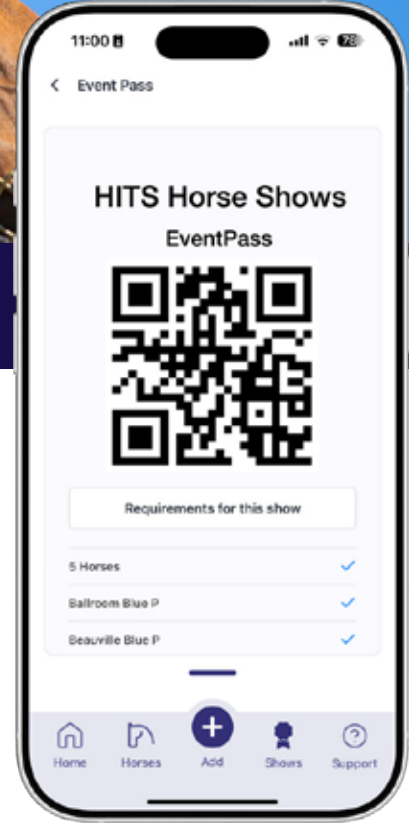

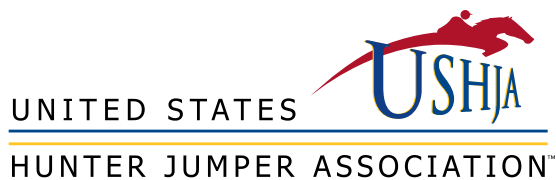

Table II.1. Limited to the first twenty teams. First come, first serve. Cut off to enter and declare in the show office is 4 pm Thursday, or when the twenty teams are reached. Open to Teams of three. Teams may consist of Juniors, Amateurs and Professionals, limited to one professional per team. Professionals may compete on two teams with different horses, Juniors and Amateurs are limited to one team. Teams are encouraged to have costumes, a team name and theme song. There will be an award for Best Team Costume. Song must be appropriate for all ages, and submitted before 5 pm Friday. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The entire team will enter the arena with their own baton. After the tone, the first rider (0.65m) will cross the start line and jump fences 1 through 5. They will then hand the baton to the second rider (.90m) and jump fences 6 through 10. The baton then is passed to the third rider (1.0m), who will jump fences 11 through 15 and cross the finish line with the baton. Three cumulative team refusals or any member with an involuntary dismount will result in elimination. In the case of a dropped baton, any team member may dismount / remount to retrieve the baton. No outside assistance with the baton, however outside assistance to remount will be permitted.

## YOUNG JUMPER PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS

Under this Program, any horse 7-Years Old or under may show in up to three “open” jumper classes at .65m-1.30m, and have the class fees waived for those classes. See details below. This is in addition to the Young Jumper 5-, 6- and 7-Year Old Jumper Classes that are already offered with a free entry fee. Horses will be eligible to receive Prize Money in classes that offer it. Special Classes, Classics, or classes restricted to Juniors or Amateurs. Exception: a class shown “hors concours” will be eligible for the Program, but prize money will not be paid. Hunter and Equitation classes will not count for this program, and will not be credited.

Horses must be age verified with USEF to participate in this program.

Horses must be Declared for the Young Jumper Program at the time of check-in each week, when back numbers are picked up for the show. At checkout, Exhibitors must review accounts with the Show Office for class credits. Horses will be credited for the class fees for the three lowest priced classes eligible for the program. Example: if the horse shows in three “Non-Nominated” jumper classes, and one “Nominated” jumper class, the three “Non-Nominated” classes will be credited. The Show office is not responsible for credits not issued for horses whose accounts are not closed out in the Show Office, or by email or remote method. Horses not declared for the Young Jumper program at check-in will not be eligible to have their class fees credited.

Horses will be charged for any Stalls, All Inclusive Facility Fee, USEF/USHJA Horse/Drug Fees, Nomination Fees and any other Association Fees (Show Pass fees, Horse or Owner/Rider/Trainer Membership fees, etc.), any Feed/Bedding, Paddocks, RV's, Restaurant Charges, and any other Miscellaneous Fees (Shoeing, Vet, Post Entry Fee, etc.), and any entry or nominating fees for classes beyond the three eligible classes showed in.

**Horses must purchase a weekly stall from the horse show to be eligible for this program. Nomination Fees will not be credited.**

Any questions or discrepancies not covered herein will be decided by Show Management, its decision to be final. Updates may made to this policy as needed. **Young Jumper classes do not count towards USHJA Young Jumper Points.**

# EQUINE HEALTH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Harold Beebe Farm | East Dorset Vermont

Protecting the health of your horse and other horses is of the utmost importance to HITS. Beginning in 2013, HITS implemented Required Biosecurity Measures to decrease the risk of introduction and/ or spread of contagious or infectious disease at its shows.

Horses must arrive only between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm daily. Off-hours arrivals must obtain permission from Show Management.

## UPON ARRIVAL TO HAROLD BEEBE FARM, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE & PROVIDE

---

### NEGATIVE COGGINS DATED WITHIN TWELVE MONTHS

---

Valid within (365 days) of the ending date of each show. This includes horses that originate from the state where the event is being held. All horses entering the Show Grounds must have a Negative Coggins on file. **Coggins must reflect the horse's SHOW NAME.**

---

### PROOF OF VACCINATION

---

Via a signed statement from the attending veterinarian that the horse has been vaccinated against the following:

**Within 6 months (180 days) of each show:** Equine Influenza

**Within 6 months (180 days) of each show:** EHV 1 and EHV 4

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for that show.

---

### HEALTH CERTIFICATE/CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (Vermont & Virginia ONLY)

---

The Vermont Agency of Agriculture and Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services require each horse originating from out of state to have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) dated within 30 days of entry into Vermont or Virginia. For Vermont ONLY the following address must be listed as the Premises of Destination: **Vermont Summer Festival**, 3028 Route 7, East Dorset, VT 05253.

---

### PRESENTATION OF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

---

**Exhibition Permits and EECVI may be used from May 1 – October 31 from eligible states.** Additional information can be found [HERE](#).

The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering the Show Grounds both Showing and Non-Showing. To ensure the safety of all horses competing at HITS managed venues, the following documentation must be uploaded through [EquiTrace EventPass](#) prior to on-site arrival.

Each horse entering the show grounds is required to have a negative coggins (within a year), proof of Flu/ Rhino and EHV 1/4 vaccinations (within 6 months) and a Health Certificate within 30 days if traveling from out of state.

**Any horse with a temperature of 101.5+ must be reported to official show veterinarian.** Upon veterinary examination, if diagnostic testing is deemed necessary, testing will be conducted at owner's expense. If veterinarian suspects infectious disease after inspection, the horse will be required to go to isolation or off the property.

# Before you arrive,

## HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS ABOUT THE BEST WAYS YOU CAN KEEP YOUR HORSES SAFE & HEALTHY

- **Temperature Monitoring:** Twice daily temperature monitoring is highly encouraged while on the competition grounds and management will provide temp logs upon request. In the event of elevated disease risk or an infectious disease incursion, management will notify competitors of mandatory twice daily temperature monitoring and recording (ideally 12 hours apart and prior to any temperature-reducing medication (i.e. Bute or Banamine). Temperature logs will be provided for placement on the stall door for recording temperatures.
  - **Limit Horse-to-Horse Contact:** Direct contact between horses from different home facilities should be minimized, and horse-to-human contact between facilities should be limited.
  - **Avoid Shared Equipment or Water Sources.** Do not share equipment between horses, and do not use communal water sources. Make sure horses have their own buckets, feed pans, grooming equipment, and rags, and limit or eliminate other equipment that touches more than one horse. Fill water buckets without submerging the hose in the buckets.
  - **Reporting a Febrile Horse:** Any horse with a temperature over 101.5F is required to be reported immediately to the official veterinarian, who will examine the horse to determine the next steps, and to horse show management. Any horse suspected of having an infectious disease will be required to immediately enter isolation stabling or be removed from the property.
  - **Reporting a Sick Horse:** Report any horse with observable signs of illness, including, but not limited to, nasal discharge, abnormal gait, change in feed or water consumption, or change in behavior to the official veterinarian and show management.
- The official veterinarian for this event is **Dr. Greg Dowd**, and he is available at **802.379.6716** during this event to take reports of fevers or illness.

## IF AN INFECTIOUS DISEASE IS SUSPECTED

- **The official veterinarian may require** a potentially sick horse to be tested for infectious disease at the owner's expense. If the owner/trainer chooses not to submit to testing, the horse may be asked to leave the competition venue.
- **Per USEF requirements**, we have a biosecurity plan in place for where and how to isolate any potentially sick or exposed horses, and we will work closely with state animal health officials to assist with contact tracing and any additional health and safety measures they require.
- **Failure to Comply with Biosecurity Measures:** Individuals who fail to comply with any biosecurity requirements will be reported to USEF for enforcement action and may be removed from the premises.

# WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and VERMONT SUMMER FESTIVAL ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

### WARNING:

**Under Vermont Law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities that are obvious and necessary, pursuant to 12 V.S.A. § 1039.**

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

# CONDITIONS & SPECIFICATIONS

## GENERAL

**Poling:** Manual poling, or the use of offsets, is prohibited on competition grounds. Per USEF GR839.

**The League presented by Marshall+Sterling Membership:** League membership is required for points to count for Classics and Classes that are affiliated with the The League presented by M+S Insurance .

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded to eighth place in all Hunter and to sixth or eighth place in Jumper Classes unless otherwise noted.

International Riders: All classes held during the 2026 Vermont Summer Festival Circuit will be run under National rules

**HJ106.2:** All horses regardless of show or non-showing are required to submit an entry with the Horse Show Office and wear or display the back number at all times. Any horse without a back number or with an incorrect back number will be asked to leave the area

**Longeing:** Horses must be longed in the official longeing areas only. All horses must wear, or be accompanied with a visible entry number. No chasing, whip cracking, or plastic bags on whips. Stirrups may not hang from the saddle while longeing. Dangerous horses will not be permitted, and will be asked to leave. No phones or radios.

## HUNTERS

**Jog:** Jogging will be conducted under HU118.3, Option A: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion. The following sections will not jog: Children's, Adult, Hi-Low, Low, Schooling, Baby Green, Young Hunter, Training Hunter, Thoroughbred Hunter, Modified Junior/Amateur, Modified Children's/Adult, Pre-Children's/Adult, Vermont Child Hunter, Vermont Adult Hunter, Short Stirrup, Schooling Pony, Green Schooling Pony.

**Warm-Up:** will be offered daily Tuesday through Thursday from 8 am - 5 pm with ring availability. Tickets are \$40 each. Back number required.

**Schooling:** is prohibited in the show rings.

**2026 Zone 1 Specifications:** Please visit USHJA.org for complete specifications.

**Adult Amateur Hunter:** To be shown by Adult Amateur Riders. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Fences 3'.

**Rider Restrictions:** Riders may Cross enter between Adult Amateur and Amateur-Owner Hunter 3'3"/3'6" if the rider owns the horse he/she is showing in the Adult Amateur division.

**Horse Restrictions:** Horses, with a different rider, may show in any other class or division at the same show except Amateur-Owner Hunter. Fences 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height.

**Horse/Rider Combination:** Horse/Rider Combination may not compete in any class where fences exceed 3', except Equitation and USHJA National Hunter Derby.

**Children's Hunter:** To be shown by Junior Exhibitors. Fences 3' for horses; 2'6" for large ponies; 2' for small and medium Ponies. No combinations for Children's Ponies.

**Rider Restrictions:** Riders may not compete in any other class at the same show where fence height exceeds 3'3" except Children's Jumper, Pony Jumper, USHJA National Derby and Equitation. Riders competing in Children's Hunter Pony may show multiple Children's Ponies and only one Regular or Green Pony, or may show multiple Regular or Green ponies and one Children's Pony.

**Horse/Pony Restrictions:** Horses, with another rider, may cross enter into any other section for which they are eligible. Ponies may not cross enter between the Children's Pony and the Regular or Green Pony sections at the same show.

## JUMPERS

**Jumper Nomination Fee:** \$200.

**Nominated Jumper Sections:** 1.20m, 1.30m, 1.40m, Open, and Junior/Amateur 1.20m-1.30m

**Non-Nominated Jumper Sections:** .65m, .80m, .90m, 1.0m, 1.10m, 1.15m, Thoroughbred Jumper, Junior/Amateur .65m-1.10m and Young Jumpers.

**Eligibility:** Any horse, regardless of winnings, is eligible to enter any .65m-1.45m and Open Jumper Class.

**Amateur Jumper:** Amateurs may compete up to two horses, they do not own, per height section of Amateur Jumpers per competition. There is no limit on the number of horses that may be ridden by the owner or an amateur member of the owner's family.

**Declarations:** Nominated Jumpers must declare on the appropriate form in the Show Office the day before the class is to be held by 4 pm. Late declarations will be subject to the Post Entry Penalty and may require the horse to work first in the order. Classes entered on the Entry Blank constitute a Declaration.

**Jumper Tables:** Refer to the Time Schedule.

**Time Allowed:** The Time Allowed will be based on a speed of 360 yards per minute for Pony Jumpers, and 382 yards per minute for all other sections unless otherwise noted, and may be adjusted accordingly.

**Draw Reins/German Martingales:** Draw reins and German martingale may not be used in any competition/class restricted to Ponies, Juniors, and/or Amateurs, or by age of horse. Draw reins and German martingales may only be used in a conventional manner when schooling or in classes with no prize money that are offered at 1.20m or below. Draw reins and/or German martingales may not be used on Ponies at any time when ridden by a Junior. No other head set devices (chambon, etc.) are permitted in any class.

**Ties:** Ties involving first place will be Jumped-Off. Ties not involving first place will be decided upon time unless otherwise stated.

**24 Hour Rule:** Horses must purchase a stall from HITS and be stabled on the grounds 24 hours prior to any class with Prize Money of \$25,000 or more.

**2026 Zone 1 Specifications:** (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

**Junior/Amateur .90m-1.0m, and Junior/Amateur 1.10m-1.15m:**

**Rider Restrictions:** Riders may not cross enter into any class where fence height exceeds 1.15m except the USEF Talent Search.

**Horse Restrictions:** Horses, with a different rider, may show in classes 1.40m (4'7") or below.

**Horse/Rider Combination Restrictions:** Horse/Rider Combination may only show in one Classic at the show if both Low and High are offered.

## SPECIAL CLASSES

### Grand Prix

- **Specs:** Table II.2.a. National Standard weeks II - V.
- **Horse Limit:** Riders are not limited to the number of horses they may ride.
- **Ranking List Points:** Riders are no longer required to designate a "Point Horse" effective December 1, 2014. Riders will receive Ranking Points from the placing points earned on his/her highest placed horse. Please visit [Ryegate.com/USEF.php](http://Ryegate.com/USEF.php) Upcoming Classes to determine which classes will be included in the Rolex Computer Ranking List.

### The League presented by M+S Insurance

- **Classic Riders:** The League membership is required for points to count for classics and classes that are affiliated with the The League presented by M+S Insurance.

**Special Hunter Classics:** Judged on performance and soundness with manners and suitability emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 (or 1/2) horses (ponies) from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied will be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, judges will confer to break the tie. All other ties will remain and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons.

- **Separate Two Round Classic:** For the first round, each competitor will jump one round of approximately 10-12 fences at the required height.
- **Designated First Round Classic:** A Designated Class of the Division will be the first round of the Classic. You must enter the Classic before competing in the First Round Class. Scratches are not permitted after the first Round Class has begun. Any horse shown in the Second Round of a Classic without being officially entered will be charged the Classic Post Entry Fee. See Time Schedule for Designated First Round Class.

**Special Class Nomination/Declaration:** Special Classes entered on the initial entry constitute a Declaration. Horses must be entered the day before the class or pay the Special Class Post Entry Fee.

**Special Class Scratch:** Any scratch must be made before the class starts or be accompanied by a Vet's Certificate. See "Rules & Regulations" for more details. In the event of a scratch on the day of the class, horses are subject to the Special Class Scratch Fee.

**Order of Go:** The Order of Go will be drawn. In the jump-off, if any, all horses will go in the original drawn order.

**Attire:** Formal attire required in Special Classes.

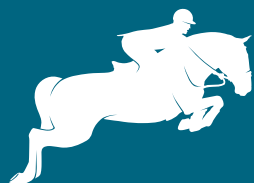
**Awards:** Winners to ride for presentation of awards in Special Classes.

# GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & REGULATIONS

## • CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION •

*Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.*

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) lead-line; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## • USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT •

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR9074. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. I acknowledge that I may opt out at any time by going to My USEF Dashboard or calling (859) 810-8733. BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at USEF.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the Horse Show and the facilities at which the Horse Show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

**ENTRY & STABLING CLOSING DATE:** Entries for the Vermont Summer Festival must be submitted online by Wednesday, June 10, 2026.

## ENTRY POLICY & PROCEDURE

- Entries must be submitted electronically through the Show Management System Online Entry platform, and must be filled out in its entirety.
- Horse Deposit Fee will be credited to the horse's entries only if the Entry is received by the Closing Date and meets the Entry Procedure.
- A Signed Open Check or Credit Card Authorization must be lodged with the Show Secretary each week before Numbers are issued.
- Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express are accepted. Customers paying by credit card should reference the Retail pricing.
- A 3% credit card fee will be applied to all credit card transactions and is nonrefundable once the card has been processed.
- Entries received after the Closing Date will be Late and subject to the Post Entry Penalty of \$75.
- Entries received after 5 pm Monday of the show will be subject to the Show Week Post Entry Penalty of \$100.
- Every account must have a valid credit card on file at HITS that will be applied to the entry charges before the back number will be issued. If there is not a credit card on file, to pick up a number a valid signed check made to HITS must be in the show office and will be used to close the account at the end of the show week.
- Accounts must be closed at the end of each show week. Exhibitors are encouraged to close out their account in person. Exhibitors who do not close out in person automatically authorize HITS to close their account using the Check / Credit Card on file.

### **Billing questions or refunds will not be considered after the show in question.**

- Any exhibitor with an unpaid balance after Sunday will be billed for these charges and a \$50 check out fee will be added to the total due.
- Entries will not be permitted to show until previous week balances are closed.
- **An All Inclusive Facility Fee of \$125** will be assessed to all showing horses. This fee entitles the horses to unlimited adds/scratches according to the add/scratch policy (does not apply to Special classes) as well as access to riding and lunging areas.
- **Non-Showing Horse** must be properly entered, wear a back-number and provide coggins and vaccinations

## GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE

Any and all disputes related to or arising from HITS' management and/or operation of its horse shows shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York without giving reference to New York's conflict of laws principles. Any disputes that cannot be resolved by the parties shall first be subject to a mediation with a New York chosen mediator. If mediation fails, the parties agree to present to arbitration at HITS' discretion under the American Arbitration Association, and if not Arbitrated, subject to litigation solely in the Courts of Ulster County New York. The parties agree the time limit to object to horse show charges shall be thirty days from the close of the horse show for the week at issue. Any other claims must be brought within one year.

## TRAINER'S BARN ACCOUNT

- Trainers must create a "Barn Account" entry to order items (tack stalls, paddocks, RVs, feed & bedding) that they intend to split.
- Trainer's Splits: This service allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until close of business Friday. Only items billed by the Horse Show such as feed, bedding, tack stalls, etc., will be split. Only dollar amounts will be split and totals will be rounded up. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.
- Trainers confirm express authority to charge client's account for trainer split charges (including feed, bedding, groom and tack stall, etc.), and authority to use client's credit card to pay those charges. Trainer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless HITS, LLC and its agents for all such charges and from any dispute arising related to the charges that is brought by client or other person or entity.

## REFUNDS

- Refund of pre-paid fees will be given for show scratches received prior to or on the Closing Date Scratch must be made in writing, according to the procedure outlined above.
- Refund for Horse Deposits, Stalls, Paddocks and RV Sites will not be given for entries scratched after the Closing Date. Exhibitors are responsible for any such outstanding fees.
- If eligible for refund, a check for refund due less an office fee of \$25 will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the final Show of the Circuit.
- Billing questions or requests for refunds will not be considered after the Show in question.

## ENTRY CLARIFICATION

- Classes may only be entered or declared by using a Class Number. A Class Number written on the Entry Form, Add Scratch Form, or Barn Add/Scratch Form or submitted online constitutes a Class Entry or Class Declaration.
- An entry with incomplete information for horse, owner, rider or trainer such as a horse entered as "Entry" or "TBA" or any such derivative, will be subject to the \$85 Incomplete Entry Fee. An entry with missing USEF/USHJA or signatures is also subject to this fee.
- Equitation riders must ride the horse and wear the number of the horse they have entered to ride. There is no penalty for the rider to scratch an Equitation Class from one horse and add it on another horse. Exhibitors who enter an equitation class on one horse and ride or wear another horse's number will be charged on both horses.
- Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class in which he/she is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the Scratch Procedures outlined below, will be billed for the class.
- Horses shown in a class without being officially entered will be assessed a penalty as shown below.
- Exhibitors are responsible for a knowledge of the Rules and Regulations governing the Horse Show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of a violation of a cross entry restriction, the exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee, class placing and prize money award.
- Show means the Show Week.
- The Horse Show policies herein stated regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of GR 912.

## POST ENTRY FEES

- **Entry received after the Closing Date** \$75
- **Incomplete Entry** \$85 (See Entry Clarification)
- **Entry received** after 5 pm Monday of the show \$100

## SCHEDULE CHANGES & UPDATES

The Class Schedule may change from week to week to include the Outside Course and other adjustments. Visit HITSShows.com for updated schedules one week prior to each show. Updated class counts and schedule changes during the competition can be found on ShowManagementSystem.com.

**ADD/SCRATCH/CHANGE** - Any class add, scratch, or change, or any complete Show Scratch must be made in writing in the Show Office on an official form or by facsimile, by letter or via the show's online add/scratch form by email and received prior to the start of the applicable class or show. Scratching a class "at the gate" does not constitute an official scratch. Once a class or division begins, it may not be scratched, except for a Vet Scratch. If a Vet Scratch, the horse must be scratched in the Show Office on the day of the class and the Official Show Vet's Certificate must be received that day. Scratch Fee will still apply. A class that has been closed may not be scratched.

**COMBINING, DIVIDING OR CANCELING DIVISIONS, CLASSES OR CLASSICS** - The Decision to Combine, Cancel or Divide classes will be made at the discretion of Show Management within one hour of the close of the Horse Show Office the night before the class. The update will be noted on the "How Many" schedule on the website.

- **Combining:** Once a class/classic/division has been combined due to insufficient entries, it will not be re-divided for additional entries on the day of the class.
- **Dividing:** A class/classic/division that has been offered as split may be combined on the day of if scratched entries warrant. Management has the right to run all sections of the class/classic/division in their entirety before pinning if insufficient entries seem likely.
- **Canceling:** A class/classic/division that has been cancelled due to insufficient entries will not be reinstated for additional entries on the day of the class.

**MOVE IN/MOVE OUT DATE RESTRICTIONS** - Note: Arrival for stabling assignments are Mondays between 3 pm and 5 pm, or Tuesday - Sunday between 8 am and 5 pm. Off-hour arrival allowed only with prior approval of Horse Show Management, and may incur additional charges.

- **Weekly Items:** Monday 3 pm to the following Monday 8 am of each Show Week, except horses staying between shows.
- **Arrival prior to Sunday noon** will incur a full week charge for the previous show week.
- **Any early arrival MUST** be approved through the Horse Show Office, please email [VermontStabling@HITSShows.com](mailto:VermontStabling@HITSShows.com), and may incur additional charges.

**STABLING** Temporary Stalls are approximately 10'x10' with doors, dirt floors. Stall Fees are non-refundable after the Closing Date of Entries. Any stall order made by Entry, Fax, Email, Phone, Text or other method will be considered an official stall order and exhibitors will be responsible for payment. Stalls are not transferable or sublettable except within the same trainer group. Exhibitors are responsible for using only those stalls assigned to them; any unassigned stall used for horses, tack, feed, grooming, dogs or storage of any item(s) will be added to the account and billed as a late weekly stall. Exhibitors should notify the show office if any stall part is in need of repair; unless notified, the Horse Show will assume the assigned stall(s) are deemed safe by the exhibitor, which should be satisfactory for USEF. Note: Some Temporary Stalls under tents may have tent support poles in them. If a stall assigned to you cannot be used for its intended purpose due to the location of the pole, please notify the Show Office and an alternate stall(s) will be assigned. Bedding on straw is prohibited except when the horse's health is at issue. Please obtain prior approval from Stable Office. Clean-up fee may apply.

- **Weekly Stall** \$375

**PADDOCKS** - A limited number of paddocks are available. Paddocks are of permanent construction. Each paddock has its own gate and exhibitors should bring their own locks to secure their paddocks. Any horse turned out in a paddock not assigned to the trainer group will incur a weekly charge for the paddock. Exhibitors should notify the Show Office if any part of their assigned paddock is in need of repair; unless notified, the Horse Show will assume the assigned paddock(s) are deemed safe by the exhibitor, which should be satisfactory for USEF. After the closing date of entries, Paddock fees are non-refundable.

## SERVICES

- **Feed Store:** Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For deliveries prior to or upon arrival, use the Feed Order form in the prize list or online at [HITSShows.com](http://HITSShows.com). Place orders by 2 pm for same day delivery. No deliveries on Sunday. Discrepancies in billing or delivery will not be considered unless brought to the attention of the Feed Office within 24 hours of placing the order. No commercial feed or bedding source will be permitted to deliver on the Vermont Summer Festival show grounds.
- **Horse Watch:** Horse Watch extends from approximately 9 pm until 5 am daily. Horses will be checked approximately 5 times a night each night of the Show Week. Trainers/owners should provide emergency contact information for Horse Watch personnel. Forms will be available in the Feed Office or in the Prize List on Feed Order form. Cell phone numbers for Horse Watch will be available in the Feed Office for trainers/owners to be able to contact Horse Watch personnel directly.
- **Trainer's Splits:** This service allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until close of business Friday. Only items billed by the Horse Show such as feed, bedding, tack stalls, etc., will be split. Only dollar amounts will be split and totals will be rounded up. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.
- **Exhibitor Check Cashing is no longer available.** Please make arrangements with local banks.

## NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

- **Returned Checks or Credit Cards**, for any reason, will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 10% of the face value of the check/credit card charge, whichever is greater. Upon notification, exhibitors will have three days to make full payment, including penalty, in certified funds, cashier's check, money order, or credit card. A 3% Retail Adjustment will be applied to all Credit Card transactions. Sanctioning organizations will be notified if exhibitors fail to pay in full within three days. A monthly service fee equal to 18% per annum will begin accruing after 30 days. Note First time returned checks will automatically be redeposited.
- **A declined credit card** will be resubmitted within several days.
- A closed account, Stop Payment, incorrect or incomplete credit card information or a chargeback will be turned over to sanctioning organizations immediately.
- **Cash Only** may be required if you have previously given a non-negotiable check to HITS.

## PRIZE MONEY

- Prize Money will be applied to entries. The Payee will default to the Owner, if the Prize Money Recipient is not provided on the submitted entry each week. A valid Social Security or Federal ID number and complete mailing address must be provided. If the SSN/EIN has not been provided to the show office within 90 days of the competition, it will be forfeited. Net Prize Money credits will be issued as a check and will be mailed or hand-delivered within 30 days after the Show, thereby ending the show's responsibility. **Exhibitors:** Please verify the correct payee and mailing address is recorded in the Show Office. **HITS is not responsible for checks lost or issued to incorrect payees.**
- If the SSN/EIN is not provided, Prize Money will be withheld until SSN / EIN is provided.
- If the IRS has notified us of a discrepancy in Payee name or SSN / EIN prize money will be withheld until the discrepancy is resolved.
- If an outstanding balance exists on an account, prize money may be withheld.
- If the SSN/EIN has not been provided to the show office within 90 days of the competition, it will be forfeited. Prize Money will not be reissued after 90 days.
- **Prize Money Won by Foreign Exhibitors** is subject to the U.S. Internal Revenue Service regulation requiring sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a Social Security number and will be asked to complete Form W-8BEN prior to receiving prize money.
- **Prize Money** is awarded through 6th place in hunter classes and through 6th or 8th place in jumper classes. A class that pays based on a number of entries will pay based on the number of on-time entries and post entries will not be included in the number used to determine the payout. Special Class Prize Money distribution is published in this book.
- A class with fewer than three entries will not award prize money.

## ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP & FEE REQUIREMENTS

### MEMBERSHIP - PEOPLE

- **Owner-Rider-Trainer:** Must be ACTIVE COMPETING members of USEF and USHJA, or join at the show, or pay Show Pass fees. Note: Owners and Riders are limited to ONE USEF Showpass per competition year, Trainers MUST be members.
- **Adult or Amateur Status:** Riders showing in classes restricted to Adults or Amateurs must have USEF Amateur Certification. Foreign Exhibitors must present documentation indicating their Amateur status with their home Federation and must JOIN USEF as ACTIVE COMPETING Members and Sign for Amateur Status.
- **Safe Sport:** Beginning January 1, 2019, All Senior members of USEF will be required to complete Safe Sport training at USEF.org before competing in a USEF Licensed competition. An exhibitor will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.
- **International Riders:** All classes held during the 2026 Vermont Summer Festival will be run under National rules with regard to riders. If the capacity of International riders exceeds the National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a First come, First served basis. All International Riders must have active, competing USEF and USHJA Memberships, as well as having completed SafeSport Training for Riders 18 and Older.

**Reminder:** USEF MAAP Requirements All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at USEF.org.

**MEMBERSHIP - FARMS & OTHER ENTITIES:** Farms, Partnerships, and any entities owning a horse competing in a USEF Licensed Competition must have one recorded owner of the entity with a current USEF Senior Active Competing Membership and USHJA Competing Membership.

### MEMBERSHIP - HORSES

- **USHJA Horse Registrations:** All horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Equitation competitions must have or apply for a Registration Number from USHJA
- **USEF Horse Recording:** Horses earning points toward USEF HOTY Awards and/or Zone Awards, USHJA Hunter Derby and or competing in Grand Prix must be Recorded with USEF Annually or for Life.
- **Microchip:** Beginning December 1, 2018, all horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Equitation competitions must have a USEF-approved Microchip on file with USEF and USHJA. Horses will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.
- **Measurement Card:** Small Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters, and Pony Jumpers must have valid USEF Measurement Card or copy of a valid Measurement Form, or be a measured at the show prior to showing. Foreign Measurement cards are not acceptable as proof of Measurement.

### MEMBERSHIP HORSE FEES:

- **Horse Fee:** USEF \$10, USHJA \$10
- **Horse Drug Fee:** USEF \$15
- **USHJA Outreach Fee (I & VI):** \$5
- **High Performance Fees:** Horses entered in Grand Prix are required to pay the \$35 IHP Fee up to a total of the cap \$420 per competition year. Please refer to the USEF website for additional information.

THE SHOW SECRETARY WILL NOT ISSUE A NUMBER TO ANY EXHIBITOR UNTIL ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET. ONCE THE NUMBER IS ISSUED, ASSOCIATION FEES, INCLUDING SHOW PASS FEES, WILL NOT BE ADJUSTED FOR THAT SHOW. Failure to provide proper credentials will result in show pass fees and/or Incomplete Entry fees charged in each incident.

**The Exhibitor has the ultimate responsibility for proper registration of horse, owner, rider and trainer with USEF/USHJA and for entering the horse under proper ownership where points are concerned.**

## HEALTH & VETERINARY

- **Sharps and Medical** – Appropriate Sharps Containers for the disposal of used Needles will be placed in all barns and tent stabling areas, at the end of aisles or at the breezeways. Sharps must only be disposed of in these containers. Anyone found in violation of proper disposal or in vandalism or removal of any provided Sharps Container will be fined \$100 and may face further penalties deemed necessary by Show Management. See GR1210.4 for complete details.
- **Show Veterinarian** phone number will be posted at the Show Office.
- **Equine Health Requirements will be enforced.** The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering the Show Grounds both Showing and Non Showing. To ensure the safety of all horses competing at HITS managed venues, the following documentation must be uploaded through EquiTrace EventPass prior to on-site arrival. Each horse entering the show grounds is required to have a negative coggins (within a year) and proof of Flu/ Rhino and EHV 1/4 vaccinations (within 6 months). Additional documents may be required based on current biosecurity climate.

HITS follows a strict biosecurity protocol. The effectiveness of our protocol depends on exhibitor's adherence to the biosecurity rules and communication with show management and official show veterinarian. Participants are expected to notify management immediately of any signs of an ill horse. Per GR873 any horse with a temperature of 101.5+ must be reported to official show veterinarian. Upon veterinary examination, if diagnostic testing is deemed necessary, testing will be conducted at owner's expense. If veterinarian suspects infectious disease after inspection, the horse will be required to go to isolation or off the property.

## SAFETY

- **Accidents Involving Competitors:** GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

- **Protective Headgear:** It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee and Licensed Official are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. GR 801.2.7.

- **Motorized Vehicles:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. Electric Golf Carts WILL NOT be permitted to plug into any electrical outlet on the grounds. Violation will result in the plug or charger being confiscated by show management, and/or a Fine if deemed necessary.

- **Dogs** must be restrained on the show grounds. Loose **Dogs** will be picked up and detained and the owner fined \$100. The owner may be barred from showing and expelled from the show grounds for a second offense, or for refusal to pay the fine, and will not be entitled to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.

- **Electrical/Fire Regulations:** Electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable Liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse. Additional appliances are not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to confiscation of the item(s).

- **Stall Alterations are strictly forbidden:** The removal of stall doors is strictly prohibited. Any exhibitor found in violation will be issued a single warning. If violation continues, Management reserves the right to remove from the show grounds all property belonging to or under the control of said violator. Further, Management reserves the right to bar any exhibitor found to be in violation from any further participation in the Horse Show without recourse to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due.

- **Stall Customizations:** As part of HITS ongoing commitment to ensure the safety of all participants, particularly the horses in this instance, as well as preserving the integrity of our facilities, we are implementing important updates to our stabling guidelines. These new guidelines apply to all events. We kindly ask for your attention to the following points: Removal of Stall Customizations: Effective immediately, all customizations to the stalls, including but not limited to nails, screws, staples, eye hooks, plastic sheeting, metal wire, twine, and the like must be removed. The use of such materials, especially staples, poses significant risks to the horses and the integrity of our facilities. We strongly recommend the elimination, or at the very least, significant limitation of staples inside the stalls. Our goal is to ensure that all stalls are safe, clean, and in their original condition (minus the bedding). Responsibility of Competitors: It is the competitors' responsibility to ensure that their staff is fully informed of and complies with these updated guidelines. We encourage team leads to hold briefings with their staff to ensure everyone is aware of these changes and understands the importance of adhering to them. Fines for Non-Compliance: In our efforts to maintain the highest standards of facility upkeep and animal safety, HITS will impose a fine of \$500 for stalls that are not left in good condition. This measure is not intended to be punitive, but rather to underscore the importance of leaving the stalls in the same condition as they were found (bedding excluded). We believe this will encourage a collective effort towards maintaining a clean and safe environment for everyone, a form of pay-it-forward to all who utilize our stabling.

- **Damage:** Owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

- **Alcoholic Beverages** in any form may not be brought onto the show grounds.

**PARCEL DELIVERIES** - Management will not be responsible for mail or parcel deliveries made to exhibitors, vendors or others. Please make arrangements accordingly.

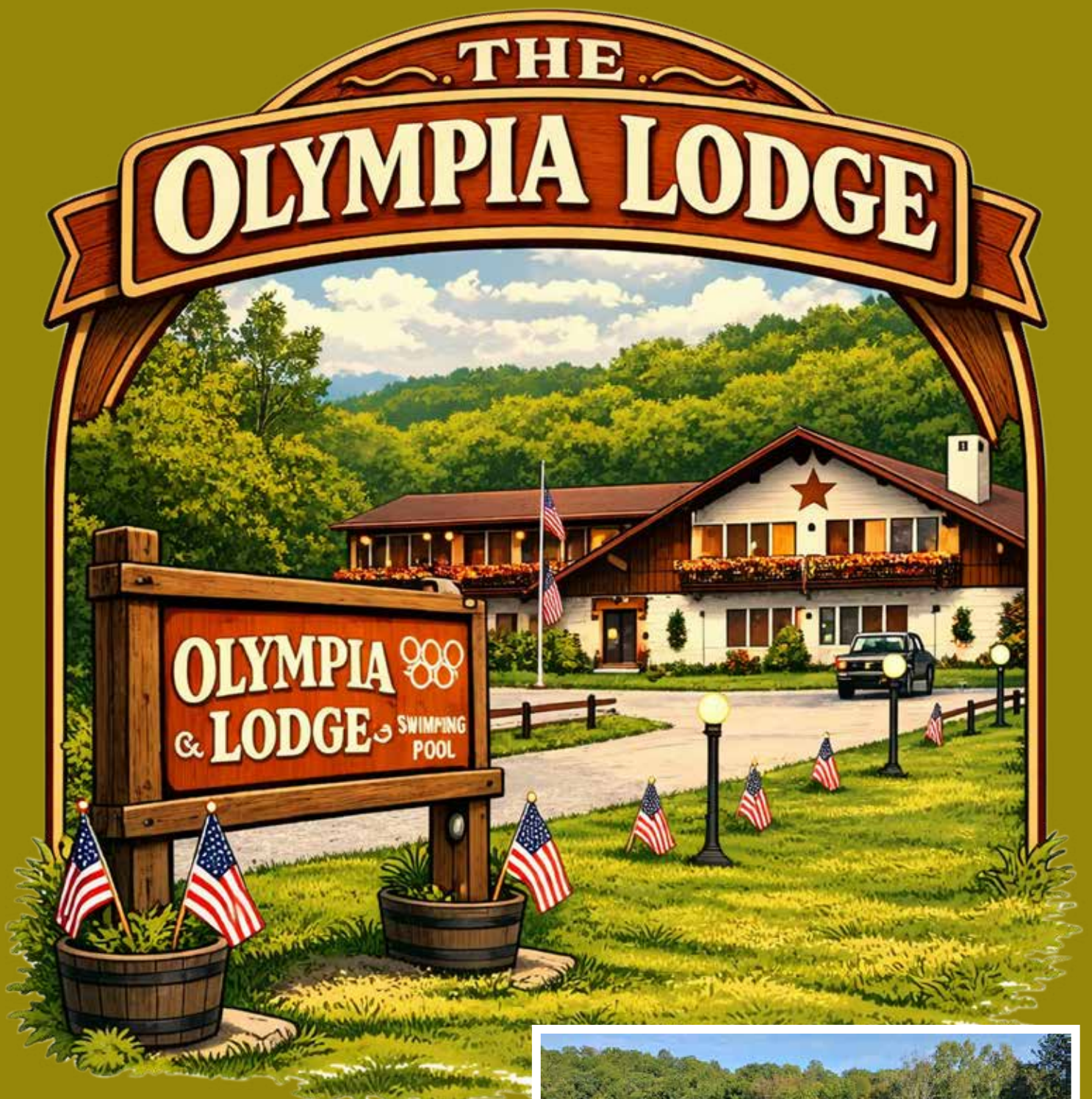
**DIRECTIONS** - Directions to the Harold Beebe Farm, East Dorset, Vermont

Turn South onto VT Route 7 South towards Manchester. Show grounds are on your left before you reach East Dorset. From CT or Central MA, traveling north on Interstate 91: Take exit #6, Route 103 West towards Chester. In Chester, take VT Route 11 West towards Londonderry. Continue West on Route 11 through Londonderry, past Bromley to VT Route 7. Turn North onto VT Route 7 through East Dorset. Show grounds are on your right, just north of East Dorset.

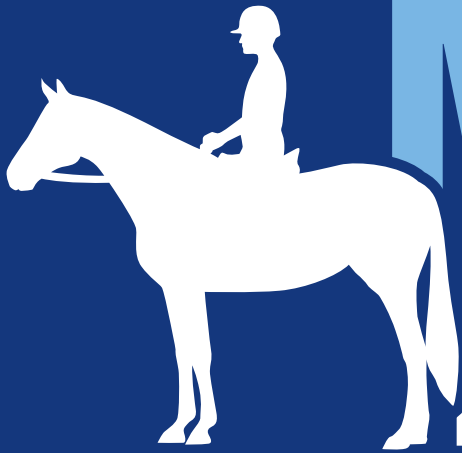
