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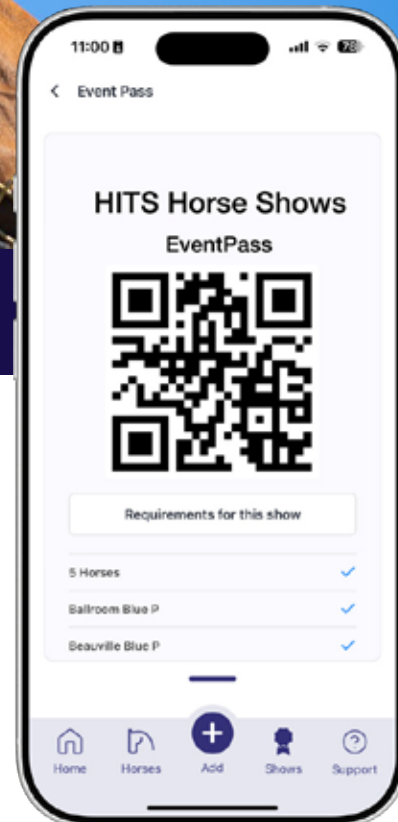

Any obstacle knocked down will not be rebuilt, if it is jumped again no points will be awarded. Competitors will accumulate points carried by each obstacle provided it is jumped clear. No points are awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Each competitor has 45 (minimum) to 90 seconds (maximum). During this time, rider must cross the starting line in either direction and may jump all the obstacles they wish in any order and in any direction. Sounding the horn declares the end of the round. The competitor must then cross the finish line in any direction for the time to be recorded. The competitor will then be allotted 20 seconds to jump the optional Joker Jump one time for a plus (clear) or minus (knock down) of 200 points. The competitor who obtains the greatest number of points will be the winner. In the event of a tie in points, the fastest time taken between the starting line and the finish line will be decided. In the event of a tie in points and time for first place, there will be a jump-off according to the same formula with a fixed time of 40 seconds.



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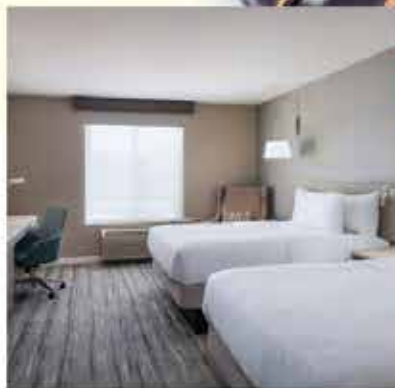

CONDITIONS & SPECIFICATIONS

ELIGIBILITY: Horses/ponies, riders, and owners (or lessee) must be an USHJA and USEF Active Competing member. The team challenge is open to riders from all Zones. All horses and riders are eligible for USHJA Zone HOTY points regardless of whether the owner or rider resides within the zone where the Championship is held. Three fence heights will be offered: 1. 3'0" Children's and Adult Amateur Hunter 2. 2'6" Low Children's and Adult Hunter, Large Children's Pony Hunter 3. 2'0" Small/Medium Children's Pony Hunter. Riders must enter the USHJA Hunt and Go Team Challenge a minimum of two hours prior to the start of the Team Challenge. Formal attire is required. Colors will be designated to differentiate teams. Riders are allowed to wear their team color throughout the Hunt and Go Team Challenge competition. Riders are only allowed to compete on one (1) horse/pony in the Hunt and Go Team Challenge. Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders. Professionals are not eligible to compete in the Hunt and Go Team Challenges. Riders entered in the Hunt and Go Team Challenge may not cross enter any class where fences exceed 3'9" at the same competition.

TEAMS: Teams will consist of a maximum of four (4) and minimum of three (3) horse/pony-and-rider combinations. Teams are determined by random draw. The construction of teams starts by filling each team with one horse/pony from each section with as many entered as teams, so each team has an even number from the sections. 1. The first teams to be created are three (3) rider teams. 2. Remaining riders after the random team creation draw, will be randomly assigned to a team. If a rider scratches after the team draw, a four (4) rider team will become a three (3) rider team system. If a rider scratches from a three (3) rider team before the start of the competition, riders will be randomly redistributed.

FORMAT: The class must be held as a one-round, two-phase, Hunt and Go course at each respective height. **The Classic Phase** will consist of five to seven fences, and shall be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. After the completion of the classic round, horses/ponies will pick up their pace, pass through a set of markers to being their handy portion of the class. **The Handy Hunter Phase** must consist of five to seven fences, and should be designed as an introduction to Handy courses. It is encouraged that the course include a bending line, roll back turn and trot fence. There will be no high options in any height section. To be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance, and a shorter track are to be rewarded. Decorations may not jump decorations or other obstacles to create a shorter track.

SCORING: A rider will receive a Classic Phase numerical score and a Handy Phase numerical score from their Hunt and Go round. That judge will provide a single numeric score (0-100) for each phase (Classic and Handy). For a four-man team, the lowest team member score in each phase will be dropped. Three- man teams will drop the lowest score and duplicate the middle score in each phase. Team Scores will be determined by adding each phase's Overall Score. The Judge will be required to score all riders in an open numerical scoring system.

OVERALL CHAMPION TEAM: The Champion Team is the team with the highest Team Score after the completion of the class. Tie-Breaking: the team with the highest combined score from the Handy Phase will break the tie. If the teams have the same combined score in the Handy, the rider with the most points from each team will answer a tie-breaking question from the USHJA Horsemanship Quiz.

AWARDS: Ribbons & Prize Money will be awarded to the 1st through 8th placed teams. Prize Money will be divided among team members

All qualifying classes will be stand-alone and will consist of a 3'6" hunter course and be judged by a single judge on a score of 1-100. Riders may enter more than one horse in the qualifying events. There must be at least six entries in a qualifying event for it to count for qualifying for the Final. A rider can only qualify once. If a rider who is already qualified rides in a subsequent qualifying class and places 1-3, the next placed unqualified rider in the class (4th place, etc) will qualify for the Final. If a rider places in the top three with more than one horse at a single qualifying event (i.e., places 1st and 3rd), that rider will qualify for the Final and the next placed unqualified rider (4th or 5th, etc) in that class will also qualify for the Final.

24 riders will qualify by placing first, second or third at one of the eight qualifying classes listed below. The 2025 winner of the ClipMyHorse.TV Hunter Classic automatically qualifies, and will be the 25th qualified rider.

Qualifying classes are open to all junior and amateur riders who pay the \$250 one-time annual nomination fee and enter the class. The entry fee for each qualifying class will be \$50. All qualifying classes will be an overlay with the 3' Adult or 3' Child Classic held at the designated qualifying show and will consist of the score from the first round only of the Classic. There must be at least six entries in each overlay class for it to count for qualifying for the Final. Riders may enter more than one horse in a qualifying class, but will receive qualifying points only for their highest placed horse in the class. Each rider can use their points from up to four of the eight qualifying classes. Restrictions on a rider jumping higher heights at the show will follow that show's Zone rules for the 3' Adult and 3' Child Classics.

The top 20 Junior Riders and top 20 Amateur Riders based on the rider's cumulative points from their best four qualifying classes will qualify to ride in the Finals. Riders with tied points will all qualify. If a qualified rider does not enter the Final, Management has the option to replace the rider with the next highest placing rider to keep the Final at 20 riders. In year two (2027) and future years, the prior year's winner of the Junior Rider and winner of the Amateur Rider Finals will automatically qualify, making 21 riders in each of the Finals (more if tied).

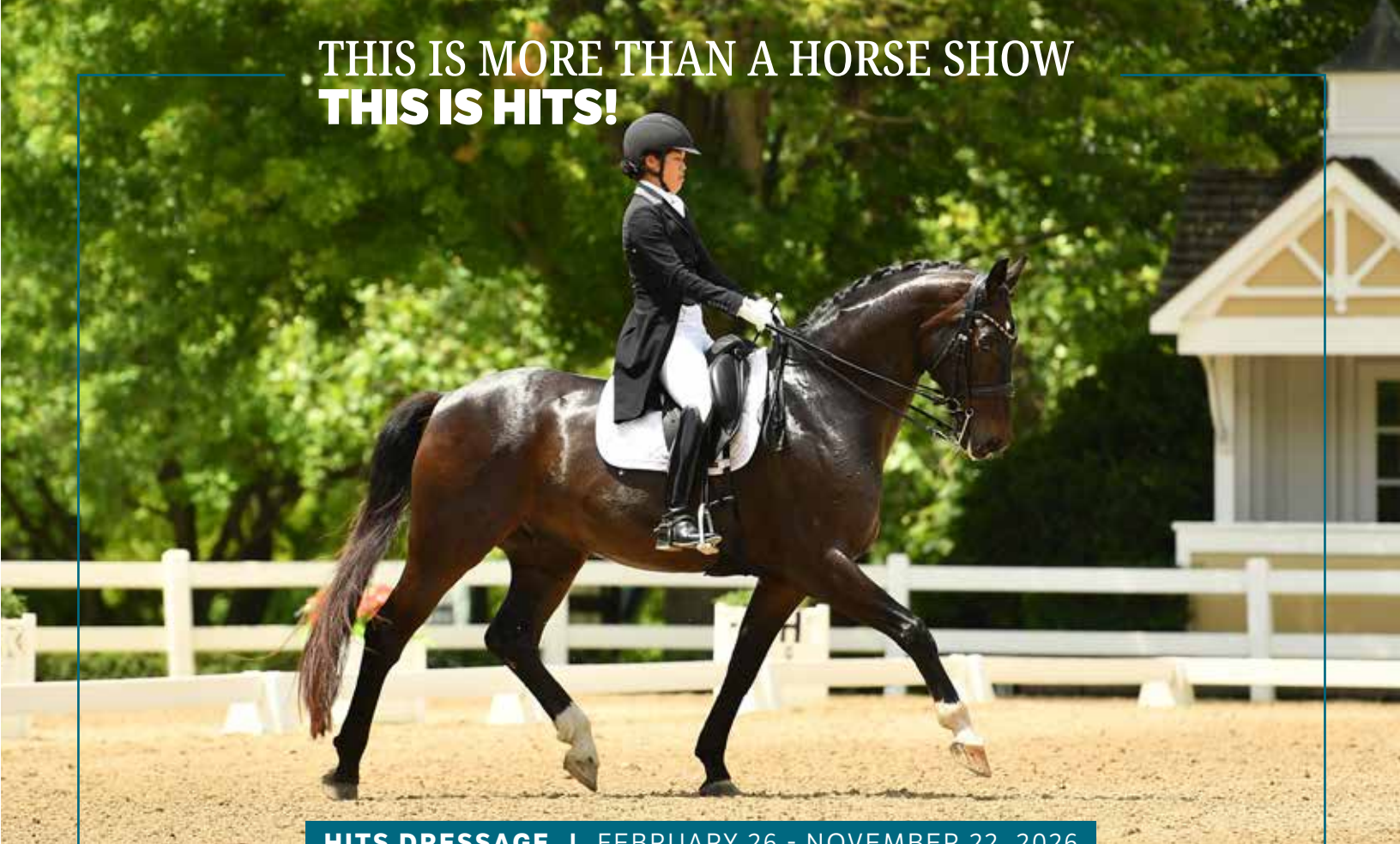

Eligibility. Age restricted classes are **open only to horses recorded and age verified with USEF**, in accordance with Federation Policies and Procedures. Age can be verified through USEF using only the following identification documents:

- a. Registration papers, Certificate of Pedigree or passport issued by a breed or sport horse registry approved by the Federation.
- b. Horse Identification Document issued by a breed or sport horse registry approved by the Federation that states the registered name of the horse, the registration number of the horse and age of the horse.

Restrictions. See also specific restrictions in each age category below.

- a. Horses may only compete in one Young Jumper height section each competition day.
- b. 4-year-olds may only compete in Young Jumper classes up to and including 1.10m.
- c. 5-year-olds may only compete in Young Jumper classes up to and including 1.20m.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and HITS Chicago Series at Lamplight ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

WARNING:

Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. EQUINE HEALTH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS **LAMPLIGHT EQUESTRIAN CENTER | WAYNE, IL**

Protecting the health of your horse and other horses at HITS Chicago is of the utmost importance to HITS. Beginning in 2013, HITS implemented Required Biosecurity Measures to decrease the risk of introduction and/or spread of contagious or infectious disease at its shows.

Horses must arrive only between the hours of 8 am - 5 pm daily. Off-hours arrival must obtain permission from Show Management by emailing LamplightStabling@HITSShows.com or by calling 845.246.5697 during competition hours.

UPON ARRIVAL TO HITS CHICAGO, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE & PROVIDE

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED DATED WITHIN TWELVE MONTHS	Required
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Valid within (365 days) of the ending date of each show. This includes horses that originate from the state where the event is being held. All horses entering the Show Grounds must have a Negative Coggins on file. Coggins must reflect the horse's SHOW NAME.

PROOF OF VACCINATION	Required
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Via a signed statement from the attending veterinarian that the horse has been vaccinated against the following:

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: **Equine Influenza**

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: **EHV 1 and EHV 4**

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for that show.

PRESENTATION OF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering the Show Grounds both Showing and Non-Showing. To ensure the safety of all horses competing at HITS managed venues, the following documentation must be uploaded through [EquiTrace Event-Pass](#) prior to on-site arrival. Each horse entering the show grounds is required to have a negative coggins (within a year) and proof of Flu/ Rhino and EHV 1/4 vaccinations (within 6 months).

Any horse with a temperature of 101.5+ must be reported to official show veterinarian. Upon veterinary examination, if diagnostic testing is deemed necessary, testing will be conducted at owner's expense. If veterinarian suspects infectious disease after inspection, the horse will be required to go to isolation or off the property.

HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS ABOUT THE BEST WAYS YOU CAN KEEP YOUR HORSES SAFE & HEALTHY

- **Temperature Monitoring:** Twice daily temperature monitoring is highly encouraged while on the competition grounds and management will provide temp logs upon request. In the event of elevated disease risk or an infectious disease incursion, management will notify competitors of **MANDATORY** twice daily temperature monitoring and recording (ideally 12 hours apart and prior to any temperature-reducing medication (i.e. Bute or Banamine). Temperature logs will be provided for placement on the stall door for recording temperatures.
 - **Limit Horse-to-Horse Contact:** Direct contact between horses from different home facilities should be minimized, and horse-to-human contact between facilities should be limited.
 - **Avoid Shared Equipment or Water Sources.** Do not share equipment between horses, and do not use communal water sources. Make sure horses have their own buckets, feed pans, grooming equipment, and rags, and limit or eliminate other equipment that touches more than one horse. Fill water buckets without submerging the hose in the buckets.
 - **Reporting a Febrile Horse:** Any horse with a temperature over 101.5F is required to be reported immediately to the official veterinarian, who will examine the horse to determine the next steps, and to horse show management. Any horse suspected of having an infectious disease will be required to immediately enter isolation stabling or be removed from the property.
 - **Reporting a Sick Horse:** Report any horse with observable signs of illness, including, but not limited to, nasal discharge, abnormal gait, change in feed or water consumption, or change in behavior to the official veterinarian and show management.
- **The official veterinarian** for this event is **Dr. Marshall Stevens**, and they are available at 616.560.2518 during this event to take reports of fevers or illness.

IF AN INFECTIOUS DISEASE IS SUSPECTED

- **The official veterinarian may require** a potentially sick horse to be tested for infectious disease at the owner's expense. If the owner/trainer chooses not to submit to testing, the horse may be asked to leave the competition venue.
- **Per USEF requirements**, we have a biosecurity plan in place for where and how to isolate any potentially sick or exposed horses, and we will work closely with state animal health officials to assist with contact tracing and any additional health and safety measures they require.
- **Failure to Comply with Biosecurity Measures:** Individuals who fail to comply with any biosecurity requirements will be reported to USEF for enforcement action and may be removed from the premises.

Poling: Manual poling, or the use of offsets, is prohibited on competition grounds. Per USEF GR839.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to eighth place in all Hunter and Jumper classes unless otherwise noted.

International Riders: All classes held during the 2026 HITS Chicago Series will be run under National rules. If the capacity of International riders exceeds National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a First come, First served basis. All International Riders must have an active, competing USEF and USHJA Memberships as well as having completed SafeSport Training for Riders 18 and Older.

HJ106.2: All horses regardless of show or non-showing are required to submit an entry with the Horse Show Office and wear or display the back number at all times. Any horse without a back number or with an incorrect back number will be asked to leave the area.

HUNTERS

Jog: Jogging will be conducted under HU118.3, Option A: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion. The following sections will not jog: Children's, Adult, Hi-Low, Schooling, Baby Green, Young, Thoroughbred Hunter, Modified Junior/Amateur, Modified Children's/Adult, Pre-Children's/Adult, Novice Child/Adult, Lamplight Child/Adult, Short Stirrup, Schooling Pony, Green Schooling Pony.

Warm-Up: Ticketed warm-up, schedule will be posted in the Show Office. Tickets are \$30 each and will be billed to the back number worn at the ring.

2026 Zone 5 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

- **Adult Amateur Hunter:** To be shown by Adult Amateur Riders. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'5" except equitation, jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Amateur-Owner Hunter and Jumper classes and the USHJA International Hunter Derby. Riders competing in the Amateur-Owner Hunter or Jumper sections may compete on one different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses can not cross enter into 3'3 or 3'6 Amateur-Owner sections at the same competition. Fences not to exceed 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height.

- **Children's Hunter:** To be shown by a Junior Rider. Riders may not cross enter into any class where the fences exceed 3'5" except equitation classes up to 3'9, jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Junior Hunter and the USHJA International Hunter Derby. Riders competing in both Children's Hunter and Junior Hunter may only ride one horse in each division. Riders competing in Children's Hunter Pony may only ride one different horse/pony in the Green or Regular Pony Hunter section and Children's Hunter Horse section, and in any class not to exceed 3'5", except Pony Jumper. Horses entered in Children's Hunter Horse classes may not cross enter into Junior Hunter sections. Fence heights to be 3' for horses; 2'6" for large ponies; 2' for small and medium ponies; spreads not to exceed fence height.

JUMPERS

Jumper Nomination Fee: \$200

Nominated Jumper Sections: 1.20m - 1.30m, Open, Jr/Am 1.20m-1.40m Jumper.

Non-Nominated Jumper Sections: .65m - 1.15m, Puddle Jumpers, Jr/Am .65m-1.10m, 1.40m Training Jumper, Take2 Thoroughbred, Cross Rail Olympic Jumper, Pony Jumper and Young Jumpers.

Eligibility: Any horse, regardless of winnings, is eligible to enter any .65m - 1.45m and Open Jumper Classes.

Amateur Jumper: Amateurs may compete up to two horses, they do not own, per height section of Amateur Jumpers per competition. There is no limit on the number of horses that may be ridden by the owner or an amateur member of the owner's family.

Declarations: Nominated Jumpers must declare on the appropriate form in the Show Office the day before the class is to be held by 5 pm. Late declarations will be subject to the Post Entry Penalty and may require the horse to work first in the order. Classes entered on the initial entry constitute a Declaration.

Jumper Tables: Refer to the Time Schedule. Management reserves the right to change tables when entries warrant.

Time Allowed: The Time Allowed will be based on a speed of 325 meters per minute for Pony Jumpers, and 350 meters per minute for all other sections unless otherwise noted, and may be adjusted accordingly.

Draw Reins/German Martingales: Draw reins and German martingale may not be used in any competition/class restricted to Ponies, Juniors, and/or Amateurs, or by age of horse. Draw reins and German martingales may only be used in a conventional manner when schooling or in classes with no prize money that are offered at 1.20m or below. Draw reins and/or German martingales may not be used on Ponies at any time when ridden by a Junior. No other head set devices (chambon, etc.) are permitted in any class.

Ties: Ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided upon time unless otherwise stated.

Secure Stabling:

- **Grand Prix:** The 24-hour stabling rule will be in effect for all Jumper classes offering prize money of \$25,000 or more. Check-in for Grand Prix horses may require the horse to be presented to HITS staff 24 hours prior to each Grand Prix at a location to be determined.

2026 Zone 5 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

- **Jr/Am 1.0m-1.05m & Jr/Am 1.10m-1.15m Jumper:** Open to Juniors and Amateurs on horses and ponies. Jr/Am 1.0m-1.05m riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. Jr/Am 1.10m-1.15m riders may not cross enter into the Jr/Am 1.40m or any other jumper class exceeding 1.30m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money. Horse/Rider combinations may cross enter between the Jr/Am 1.0m-1.05m and the Jr/Am 1.10m-1.15m Jumper at the same competition.

SPECIAL CLASSES - The General Rules and Regulations of the Horse Show will prevail for the Special Classes except as provided for each individual class and as noted herein.

Grand Prix:

- **Specs:** Table II.2.a. American Standard.
- **Ranking List Points:** Riders are no longer required to designate a "Point Horse" effective December 1, 2014. Riders will receive Ranking Points from the placing points earned on his/her highest placed horse.

The League presented by Marshall+Sterling Insurance:

- **Classic Riders:** Membership for The League presented by M+S Insurance is required for points to count for Classics and Classes that are affiliated with the The League.

Special Hunter Classics: Judged on performance and soundness with manners and suitability emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 (or 50% whichever is greater) horses or ponies from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied will be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, judges will confer to break the tie. All other ties will remain and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons.

- **Separate Two Round Classic:** For the first round, each competitor will jump one round of approximately 10-12 fences at the required height.

• **Designated First Round Classic:** A Designated Class of the Division will be the first round of the Classic. You must enter the Classic before competing in the First Round Class. Scratches are not permitted after the First Round Class has begun. Any horse shown in the Second Round of a Classic without being officially entered will be charged the classic Post Entry Fee. See Time Schedule for Designated First Round Class.

Special Class Nomination/Declaration: Special Classes entered on the initial entry constitute a Declaration. Horses must be entered the day before the class or pay the Special Class Post Entry Fee.

Special Class Scratch: Any scratch must be made before the class starts or be accompanied by a Vet's Certificate. See "Rules & Regulations" for more details. In the event of a scratch on the day of the class, horses are subject to the Special Class Scratch Fee.

Order of Go: The Order of Go will be drawn. In the jump-off, if any, all horses will go in the original drawn order.

Attire: Formal attire required in Special Classes.

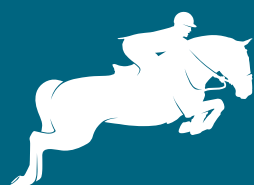

GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & REGULATIONS

• CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION •

Every class offered herein that is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

• USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT •

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the HITS Chicago Series at Lamplight. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR9074. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. I acknowledge that I may opt out at any time by going to My USEF Dashboard or calling (859) 810-8733. BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at USEF.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

ENTRY POLICY & PROCEDURE

- Entries must be submitted electronically through the Show Management System Online Entry platform, and must be filled out in its entirety.
- Horse Deposit Fee will be credited to the horse's entries only if the Entry is received by the Closing Date and meets the Entry Procedure.
- A Signed Open Check or Credit Card Authorization must be lodged with the Show Secretary each week before Numbers are issued.
- Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express are accepted. Customers paying by credit card should reference the Retail pricing.
- Retail prices will be charged for all Credit Card transactions, which as of August 10, 2026 are 3.5% higher than the prices in this Prize List, which is non-refundable once the card has been processed.
- Entries received after the Closing Date will be late and subject to the Post Entry Penalty of \$75.
- Entries received after 5 pm Monday of the show will be subject to the Show Week Post Entry Penalty of \$100.
- Every account must have a valid credit card on file at HITS that will be applied to the entry charges before the back number will be issued. If there is not a credit card on file, to pick up a number a valid signed check made to HITS must be in the show office and will be used to close the account at the end of the show week.
- Accounts must be closed at the end of each show week. Exhibitors are encouraged to close out their account in person. Exhibitors who do not close out in person automatically authorize HITS to close their account using the Check / Credit Card on file.

Billing questions or refunds will not be considered after the show in question.

- Any exhibitor with an unpaid balance after Sunday will be billed for these charges and a \$50 check out fee will be added to the total due.
- Entries will not be permitted to show until previous week balances are closed.
- **An All Inclusive Facility Fee of \$125** will be assessed to all showing horses. This fee entitles the horses to unlimited adds/scratches according to the add/scratch policy (does not apply to Special classes) as well as access to riding and lungeing areas.
- **Non-Showing Horse** must be properly entered, wear a back-number and provide coggins and vaccinations and **will be charged a fee of \$50 weekly.**
- **Wayne County Entertainment Tax of \$12.50** will be charged to all showing horses.

GOVERNING LAW & VENUE

Any and all disputes related to or arising from HITS' management and/or operation of its horse shows shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York without giving reference to New York's conflict of laws principles. Any disputes that cannot be resolved by the parties shall first be subject to a mediation with a New York chosen mediator. If mediation fails, the parties agree to present to arbitration at HITS' discretion under the American Arbitration Association, and if not Arbitrated, subject to litigation solely in the Courts of Ulster County New York. The parties agree the time limit to object to horse show charges shall be thirty days from the close of the horse show for the week at issue. Any other claims must be brought within one year.

TRAINER'S BARN ACCOUNT

- Trainers must create a "Barn Account" entry to order items (tack stalls, paddocks, RVs, feed & bedding) that they intend to split.
- Trainer's Splits: This service allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until close of business Friday. Only items billed by the Horse Show such as feed, bedding, tack stalls, etc., will be split. Only dollar amounts will be split and totals will be rounded up. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.
- Trainers confirm express authority to charge client's account for trainer split charges (including feed, bedding, groom and tack stall, etc.), and authority to use client's credit card to pay those charges. Trainer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless HITS, LLC and its agents for all such charges and from any dispute arising related to the charges that is brought by client or other person or entity.

REFUNDS

- Refund of pre-paid fees will be given for show scratches received prior to or on the Closing Date Scratch must be made in writing, according to the procedure outlined above.
- Refund for Horse Deposits, Stalls, Paddocks and RV Sites will not be given for entries scratched after the Closing Date. Exhibitors are responsible for any such outstanding fees.
- If eligible for refund, a check for refund due less an office fee of \$25 will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the final Show of the Circuit.
- Billing questions or requests for refunds will not be considered after the Show in question.

ENTRY CLARIFICATION

- Classes may only be entered or declared by using a Class Number. A Class Number written on the Entry Form, Add Scratch Form, or Barn Add/Scratch Form or submitted online constitutes a Class Entry or Class Declaration.
- An entry with incomplete information for horse, owner, rider or trainer such as a horse entered as "Entry" or "TBA" or any such derivative, will be subject to the \$85 Incomplete Entry Fee. An entry with missing USEF/USHJA or signatures is also subject to this fee.
- Equitation riders must ride the horse and wear the number of the horse they have entered to ride. There is no penalty for the rider to scratch an Equitation Class from one horse and add it on another horse. Exhibitors who enter an equitation class on one horse and ride or wear another horse's number will be charged on both horses.
- Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class in which he/she is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the Scratch Procedures outlined below, will be billed for the class.
- Horses shown in a class without being officially entered will be assessed a penalty as shown below.
- Exhibitors are responsible for a knowledge of the Rules and Regulations governing the Horse Show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of a violation of a cross entry restriction, the exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee, class placing and prize money award.
- Show means the Show Week.
- The Horse Show policies herein stated regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of GR 912.

- HITS encourages positivity in the use of social media platforms and urges persons posting information about HITS, its management, shows, exhibitors, officials, equine athletes, and others to exercise good judgment and think about the potential consequences of their posts and interactions on social media platforms. We urge those using social media to refrain from making derogatory, offensive, inflammatory, or false comments about other athletes, trainers, HITS and its management, our equine athletes, USEF, or any individuals associated with our HITS horse shows. HITS reserves the right to remove third-party content from its social media platforms that violates its social media policy and in extenuating circumstances may block a user from HITS social media sites for repeated offenses of its policy.

ADD/SCRATCH/CHANGE: Any class add, scratch, or change, or any complete Show Scratch must be made in writing in the Show Office on an official form or via ShowManagementSystem and received prior to the start of the applicable class or show. Scratching a class "at the gate" does not constitute an official scratch. Once a class or division begins, it may not be scratched, except for a Vet Scratch. If a Vet Scratch, the horse must be scratched in the Show Office on the day of the class and the Official Show Vet's Certificate must be received that day. Scratch Fee will still apply. A class that has been closed may not be scratched.

COMBINING, DIVIDING OR CANCELING DIVISIONS, CLASSES OR CLASSICS: The Decision to Combine, Cancel or Divide classes will be made at the discretion of Show Management within one hour of the close of the Horse Show Office the night before the class. The update will be noted on the "How Many" schedule on the website.

- **Combining:** Once a class/classic/division has been combined due to insufficient entries, it will not be re-divided for additional entries on the day of the class.
- **Dividing:** A class/classic/division that has been offered as split may be combined on the day of if scratched entries warrant. Management has the right to run all sections of the class/classic/division in their entirety before pinning if insufficient entries seem likely.
- **Canceling:** A class/classic/division that has been canceled due to insufficient entries will not be reinstated for additional entries on the day of the class.

MOVE IN / MOVE OUT DATE RESTRICTIONS: Arrival for stabling assignments must be between the hours of Noon -5 pm Monday, 8 am - 5 pm, Tuesday through Sunday. Off-hour arrival allowed only with prior approval of Horse Show Management.

- **Weekly Items:** Stalls can be occupied Monday, Noon to the following Monday, 8 am of each Show Week. Arrival prior to Monday at Noon will incur a charge for early arrival, and must be organized through the Stabling Manager. Early arrival will be charged at \$50 per day, however arrivals prior to Saturday of the show week will be charged the weekly rate.

PADDOCKS: Approximately 10 turnout paddocks will be available. Preference will be given to multiple-week reservations. Each paddock has its own gate and exhibitors should bring their own locks to secure their paddocks. Any horse turned out in a paddock not assigned to the trainer group will incur a weekly charge for the paddock. Exhibitors should notify the Show Office if any part of the their assigned paddock is in need of repair; unless notified, the Horse Show will assume the assigned paddock(s) are deemed safe by the exhibitor, which should be satisfactory for USEF. After the closing date of entries, Paddock fees are non-refundable. Paddocks ordered after the closing date of entries will be accepted on a space available basis and may be subject to a Late Paddock fee of \$50 additional per week.

RV SPACES: On-site RV spaces include water and 30 AMP electric hook-up. On-site spaces are limited and preference will be given to multiple-week reservations. RV Spaces are non-refundable after the closing date of entries. RV Sites ordered after the closing date of entries will be accepted on a space available basis and may be subject to a Late RV fee of \$50 additional per week. Note: Any RV left parked in the RV area, whether hooked up or not, will incur a weekly fee of \$350 per week or any portion thereof. No exceptions. Septic pump outs may be arranged through the show office by 5pm the day prior, for a fee of \$50 per pump.

If a stall assigned to you cannot be used for its intended purpose due to the location of the pole, please notify the Show Office and an alternate stall(s) will be assigned. Stall Fees are non-refundable after the Closing Date of Entries. Any stall order made by Entry, Fax, Email, Phone, Text or other method will be considered an official stall order and exhibitors will be responsible for payment. Stalls are not transferable or sublettable except within the same trainer group. Any showing horse, that has not purchased a stall from HITS will be assessed the Ship-in/Grounds fee per week. Exhibitors are responsible for using only those stalls assigned to them; any unassigned stall used for horses, tack, feed, grooming, dogs or storage of any item(s) will be added to the account and billed as a late weekly stall. Exhibitors should notify the show office if any stall part is in need of repair; unless notified, the Horse Show will assume the assigned stall(s) are deemed safe by the exhibitor, which should be satisfactory for USEF. Bedding on straw is prohibited except when the horse's health is at issue. Please obtain prior approval from Stable Office. Clean-up fee may apply. Shavings are to be purchased on-site. Any off-site shavings will result in an additional \$25 manure disposal fee per stall. Permanent Stalls available on a limited basis. Preference will be given to Lamplight Club Members. STALL CUSTOMIZATIONS: As part of HITS ongoing commitment to ensure the safety of all participants, particularly the horses in this instance, as well as preserving the integrity of our facilities, we are implementing important updates to our stabling guidelines. These new guidelines apply to all events. We kindly ask for your attention to the following points: Removal of Stall Customizations: Effective immediately, all customizations to the stalls, including but not limited to nails, screws, staples, eye hooks, plastic sheeting, metal wire, twine, and the like must be removed. The use of such materials, especially staples, poses significant risks to the horses and the integrity of our facilities. We strongly recommend the elimination, or at the very least, significant limitation of staples inside the stalls. Our goal is to ensure that all stalls are safe, clean, and in their original condition (minus the bedding). Responsibility of Competitors: It is the competitors' responsibility to ensure that their staff is fully informed of and complies with these updated guidelines. We encourage team leads to hold briefings with their staff to ensure everyone is aware of these changes and understands the importance of adhering to them. Fines for Non-Compliance: In our efforts to maintain the highest standards of facility upkeep and animal safety, HITS will impose a fine of \$500 for stalls that are not left in good condition. This measure is not intended to be punitive, but rather to underscore the importance of leaving the stalls in the same condition as they were found (bedding excluded). We believe this will encourage a collective effort towards maintaining a clean and safe environment for everyone, a form of pay-it-forward to all who utilize our stabling.

LAMPLIGHT CLUB MEMBERSHIP: A great opportunity for barns to both promote and elevate their brands while supporting a positive and inclusive environment at the horse show. By joining the Lamplight Club, businesses can help HITS enhance the overall experience for exhibitors while also increasing their visibility within the horse community. SERVICES

- **Feed Store** Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For deliveries prior to or upon arrival, use the Feed Order form in the prize list or online. Place orders by noon for same day delivery. No deliveries on Sunday. Questions with regard to feed and bedding charges will not be considered after noon Friday. Discrepancies in deliveries will not be considered unless brought to the attention of the Feed Office within 24 hours of placing the order. No commercial feed or bedding source will be permitted to deliver on the show grounds.
- **Horse Watch** Horses stabled on the grounds will receive Horse Watch provided by HITS Staff. Horse Watch extends from approximately 9 pm until 5 am daily. Horses will be checked approximately 5 times a night each night of the Show Week. Trainers/owners should provide emergency contact information for Horse Watch personnel. Forms will be available in the Feed Office or in the Prize List on Feed Order form. Cell phone numbers for Horse Watch will be available in the Feed Office for trainers/owners to be able to contact Horse Watch personnel directly.
- **Trainer's Splits** This service allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until noon on Friday. Only items billed by the horse show such as feed, bedding, tack stalls, etc., will be split. Only dollar amounts will be split and totals will be rounded up. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.
- **Exhibitor Check Cashing** is no longer available. Please make arrangements with local banks.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

- **Returned Checks or Credit Cards**, for any reason, will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 10% of the face value of the check/credit card charge, whichever is greater. Upon notification, exhibitors will have three days to make full payment, including penalty, in certified funds, cashier's check, money order, or credit card. A 3.5% Retail Adjustment will be applied to all Credit Card transactions. Sanctioning organizations will be notified if exhibitors fail to pay in full within three days. A monthly service fee equal to 18% per annum will begin accruing after 30 days. **Note:** First time returned checks will automatically be redeposited.
- **A declined credit card** will be resubmitted within several days.
- A closed account, Stop Payment, incorrect or incomplete credit card information or a chargeback will be turned over to sanctioning organizations immediately.
- **Cash Only** may be required if you have previously given a non-negotiable check to HITS.

PRIZE MONEY

- **Prize Money will be applied to entries.** The Payee will default to the Owner, if the Prize Money Recipient is not provided on the submitted entry each week. A valid Social Security or Federal ID number and complete mailing address must be provided. If the SSN/EIN has not been provided to the show office within 90 days of the competition, it will be forfeited. Net Prize Money credits will be issued as a check and will be mailed or hand-delivered within 30 days after the Show, thereby ending the show's responsibility. **Exhibitors:** Please verify the correct payee and mailing address is recorded in the Show Office. **HITS is not responsible for checks lost or issued to incorrect payees.**
- If the SSN/EIN is not provided, Prize Money will be withheld until SSN / EIN is provided.
- If the IRS has notified us of a discrepancy in Payee name or SSN / EIN prize money will be withheld until the discrepancy is resolved.
- If an outstanding balance exists on an account, prize money may be withheld.
- If the SSN/EIN has not been provided to the show office within 90 days of the competition, it will be forfeited. Prize Money will not be reissued after 90 days.
- **Prize Money Won by Foreign Exhibitors** is subject to the U.S. Internal Revenue Service regulation requiring sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a Social Security number and will be asked to complete Form W-8BEN prior to receiving prize money.
- **Prize Money** is awarded through 6th place in hunter classes and through 6th or 8th place in jumper classes. A class that pays based on a number of entries will pay based on the number of on-time entries and post entries will not be included in the number used to determine the payout. Special Class Prize Money distribution is published in this book.
- A class with fewer than three entries will not award prize money.

ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP & FEE REQUIREMENTS

MEMBERSHIP - PEOPLE

- **Owner-Rider-Trainer:** Must be ACTIVE COMPETING members of USEF and USHJA, or join at the show, or pay Show Pass fees. Note: Owners and Riders are limited to ONE USEF Showpass per competition year, Trainers MUST be members.
- **Adult or Amateur Status:** Riders showing in classes restricted to Adults or Amateurs must have USEF Amateur Certification. Foreign Exhibitors must present documentation indicating their Amateur status with their home Federation and must JOIN USEF as ACTIVE COMPETING Members and Sign for Amateur Status.
- **Safe Sport:** Beginning January 1, 2019, All Senior members of USEF will be required to complete Safe Sport training at USEF.org before competing in a USEF Licensed competition. An exhibitor will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.
- **International Riders:** All classes held during the 2026 HITS Chicago Series will be run under National rules with regard to riders. If the capacity of International riders exceeds the National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a First come, First served basis. All International Riders must have an active, competing USEF & USHJA Memberships as well as having completed SafeSport Training for Riders 18 and Older.

Reminder: USEF MAAP Requirements All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at USEF.org.

MEMBERSHIP - FARMS & OTHER ENTITIES: Farms, Partnerships, and any entities owning a horse competing in a USEF Licensed Competition must be Recorded with USEF, and one recorded owner of the entity must have a current Senior USEF and USHJA Competing Memberships.

MEMBERSHIP - HORSES

- **USHJA Horse Registrations:** All horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Equitation competitions must have or apply for a Registration Number from USHJA
- **USEF Horse Recording:** Horses earning points toward USEF HOTY Awards and/or Zone Awards, USHJA Hunter Derby and or competing in Grand Prix must be Recorded with USEF Annually or for Life.
- **Microchip:** Beginning December 1, 2018, all horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Equitation competitions must have a USEF-approved Microchip on file with USEF and USHJA. Horses will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.
- **Measurement Card:** Small Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters, and Pony Jumpers must have valid USEF Measurement Card or copy of a valid Measurement Form, or be a measured at the show prior to showing. Foreign Measurement cards are not acceptable as proof of Measurement.

MEMBERSHIP HORSE FEES:

- **Horse Fee:** USEF \$10, USHJA \$10
- **Horse Drug Fee:** USEF \$15

THE SHOW SECRETARY WILL NOT ISSUE A NUMBER TO ANY EXHIBITOR UNTIL ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET. ONCE THE NUMBER IS ISSUED, ASSOCIATION FEES, INCLUDING SHOW PASS FEES, WILL NOT BE ADJUSTED FOR THAT SHOW. Failure to provide proper credentials will result in show pass fees and/or Incomplete Entry fees charged in each incident.

The Exhibitor has the ultimate responsibility for proper registration of horse, owner, rider and trainer with USEF/USHJA and for entering the horse under proper ownership where points are concerned. Exhibitors will be responsible for any fees or fines charged by USEF/USHJA or other sanctioning organizations for missing, incorrect, expired or nonexistent memberships, recordings or other requirements.

SAFETY

- **Trauma 1 Center:** AMITA Health Mercy Medical Center Aurora, 1325 N Highland Ave, Aurora, IL 60506, 855-692-6482, 15 miles (27 minutes) by car
- **Accidents Involving Competitors:** GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.
- **Protective Headgear** is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee and Licensed Official are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. GR 801.2.7.
- **Motorized Vehicles & Golf Carts.** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- **The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices,** as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- **Electric Golf Carts** will not be permitted to plug into any electrical outlet on the grounds.
- **Dogs must be restrained on the show grounds.** Loose dogs will be picked up and detained and the owner fined \$100. The owner may be barred from showing and expelled from the show grounds for a second offense, or for refusal to pay the fine, and will not be entitled to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- **Electrical/Fire Regulations.** Electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable Liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse. Additional appliances are not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to confiscation of the item(s).
- **Stall Alterations are strictly forbidden.** The removal of stall tent side poles, side ropes and/or stakes/anchors is strictly prohibited. Any exhibitor found in violation will be issued a single warning. If violation continues, Management reserves the right to remove from the show grounds all property belonging to or under the control of said violator. Further, Management reserves the right to bar any exhibitor found to be in violation from any further participation in the horse show without recourse to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due.
- **Damage.** Owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

HEALTH & VETERINARY

- **Equine Health Requirements will be enforced.** The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering the Show Grounds both Showing and Non Showing. To ensure the safety of all horses competing at HITS managed venues, the following documentation must be uploaded through EquiTrace EventPass prior to on-site arrival. Each horse entering the show grounds is required to have a negative coggins (within a year) and proof of Flu/ Rhino and EHV 1/4 vaccinations (within 6 months). Additional documents may be required based on current biosecurity climate.

HITS follows a strict biosecurity protocol. The effectiveness of our protocol depends on exhibitor's adherence to the biosecurity rules and communication with show management and official show veterinarian. Participants are expected to notify management immediately of any signs of an ill horse. Per GR873 any horse with a temperature of 101.5+ must be reported to official show veterinarian. Upon veterinary examination, if diagnostic testing is deemed necessary, testing will be conducted at owner's expense. If veterinarian suspects infectious disease after inspection, the horse will be required to go to isolation or off the property.

- **Sharps & Medical Waste** – Appropriate Sharps Containers for the disposal of used Needles will be placed in all barns and tent stabling areas, at the end of aisles or at the breezeways. Sharps must only be disposed of in these containers. Anyone found in violation of proper disposal or in vandalism or removal of any provided Sharps Container will be fined \$100 and may face further penalties deemed necessary by Show Management. See GR1210.4 for complete details.
- **Show Veterinarian** phone number will be posted at the Show Office.
- **Alcoholic Beverages** in any form may not be brought onto the show grounds.

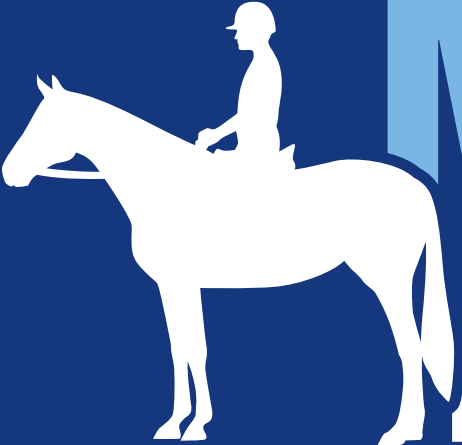
